## **Driving Directions and Parking Information**

Getting to Green River Community College  
12401 SE 320<sup>th</sup> St, Auburn, WA 98092

### **From Highway 167, north or southbound:**

Take the 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE exit and head east into Auburn. Continue on 15<sup>th</sup> Ave when it becomes Harvey Road (the Shell and Chevron stations mark this transition). Drive 0.5 miles to the next Shell station and turn left onto 8<sup>th</sup> Ave NE. Of the two lanes that turn left, choose the inside one and follow the road as it winds up the hill. At the second traffic light, turn right onto 105<sup>th</sup> Place SE\*. Following the hairpin turns of this road will lead you straight to GRCC.

\*If you miss this turn, keep driving until you see Circle K and turn right. Goof-proof!

### **From I-5, north or southbound:**

Take the Hwy 18 East exit. Drive approximately 9 miles. Take the 304<sup>th</sup> St exit and turn onto 304<sup>th</sup> St heading west. Drive straight through the first traffic light (stopping, of course, if it is red) and turn left at the second traffic light. There is a fire station on your left and the Circle K is across the street. Drive until you see the signs for GRCC.

### **Parking:**

There are two entrances to the Green River campus. Sadly, you will have to bypass the west entrance marked "Holman Library" (Lot A) and use the east or "Main" entrance (Lots C-D). Stop at the parking booth and identify yourself as an attendee of the CLAMS conference. You will be directed to parking reserved for us.
